



SPECTATOR INSTRUCTIONS - ACCENT BENCHTOPS WORKING DOG RALLY



20TH JULY 2019 - RALLY HQ AND SERVICE PARK BONALBO SHOWGROUND NSW

Notes: The roads being traversed are narrow, twisty, and sometimes bumpy. Local residents will not be used to a high volume of traffic on these roads. Be courteous of other road users and leave plenty of time to get to your location. Police will be patrolling these roads. You will not be able to see 'your car' at spectator point 1, leave, and get to spectator point 2 before them. Distances are accumulative.

Bonalbo Showground to Spectator Point 1 Red Dog / Kelpie

Allow 20 minutes- 18 km. First car due at: 9.03am; 12.39pm; 3.05pm; 5.31pm.

- Turn left out of the Bonalbo Showground onto Clarence Way. Zero trip meter.
- At 14km turn left into Tunglebung Creek Road. Caution: This is a narrow tarmac road and rally cars are liaising on this road. Spectator traffic will also be travelling in both directions.
- At 15.7km turn right onto Armstrong Road. Caution: This is a gravel road with crests. Spectator traffic will be travelling in both directions.
- Arrive 18km Spectator Point. Park off the road and leave the road open in case of an emergency.

Bonalbo Showground to Spectator Point 2 Brown Dog

Allow 30 minutes – 31.4km. First Car due at: 9.40am; 1.16pm; 6.04pm

- Turn left out of the Bonalbo Showground onto Clarence Way. Zero trip meter.
- At 22.8km turn right onto the Bruxner Highway. Caution: This is a major highway and traffic will be travelling at increased speed.
- At 24.8km you may see rally cars exiting Clarence Way. This is the end of the stage. DO NOT drive onto this road. You will be turned away.
- At 28.5km turn hard left onto Captains Way (Signposted 128 Grafton). This is a gravel road. Extreme Caution: The intersection is at the top of a brow and is difficult to see as you approach. Give ample warning to following traffic of your intentions of turning left.
- At 30.9km turn hard left onto Clarence Way.
- Arrive 31.4km Spectator Point. Park off the road and leave the road open in case of an emergency. Walk 300 meters to the spectator point by keeping left. DO NOT veer to the right. You will be turned back.

From Spectator Point 1 to Spectator Point 2

Allow 22 minutes – 21.4km First Car due at: 9.40am; 1.16pm; 6.04pm

Zero tripmeter. Return along Armstrong Road. Caution on crests.

- At 2.3km turn left onto Tunglebung Creek Road. Caution: Rally cars will be liaising on this road.
- AT 4.00km turn left onto Clarence Way.
- At 12.8km turn right onto Bruxner Hwy. Caution: This is a major highway and traffic will be travelling at increased speed.
- At 14.8km you may see rally cars exiting Clarence Way. This is the end of the stage. DO NOT drive onto this road. You will be turned away.
- At 18.5km turn hard left onto Captains Way (Signposted 128 Grafton). This is a gravel road. Extreme Caution: The intersection is at the top of a brow and is difficult to see as you approach. Give ample warning to following traffic of your intentions of turning left.
- At 20.9km turn hard left onto Clarence Way.
- Arrive 21.4km Spectator Point. Park off the road and leave the road open in case of an emergency. Walk 300 meters to the spectator point by keeping left. DO NOT veer to the right. You will be turned back.

EXCLUSION OF LIABILITY, RELEASE & INDEMNITY

In exchange for being able to attend or participate in Motor Sport Activities, I agree:

- to release CAMS and the Entities to the extent that any or all of them are providing Recreational Services from all liability for:
 - my death;
 - any physical or mental injury (including the aggravation, acceleration or recurrence of such an injury);
 - the contraction, aggravation or acceleration of a disease;
 - the coming into existence, the aggravation, acceleration or recurrence of any other condition, circumstance, occurrence, activity, form of behaviour, course of conduct or state of affairs;
 - that is or may be harmful or disadvantageous to me or the community; or
 - that may result in harm or disadvantage to me or the community;
- howsoever arising from my participation in or attendance at the Motor Sport Activities;
- to indemnify and hold harmless and keep indemnified CAMS and the Entities to the maximum extent permitted by law in respect of any Claim by any person;
- to be bound to the rules, regulations and policies of the Entities; and
- to attend at or participate in the Motor Sport Activities at my own risk.

I understand that:

- nothing in this document excludes, restricts or modifies any rights that I may have as a result of significant personal injury that is caused by the Reckless Conduct of CAMS and the Entities as the supplier of Motor Sport Activities / Recreational Services;
- nothing in this document prevents the Entities from relying on any laws (including statute and common law) that limit or preclude their liability;
- nothing in this document excludes any term or guarantee which under statute cannot be excluded; however the liability of the Entities is limited to the minimum liability allowable by law;
- nothing in this document precludes me from making a claim under a CAMS insurance policy where I am expressly entitled to make a claim under that insurance policy; and
- CAMS has arranged some limited personal injury insurance coverage which may provide me with some protection for loss, damage or injury that I may suffer during my participation in the Motor Sport Activities. However, I acknowledge and accept that the insurance taken out by CAMS may not provide me with full indemnity for loss, damage or injury that I may suffer during my participation in the Motor Sport Activities, and that I may have to pay the excess if a Claim is made under an insurance policy on my behalf. I agree that my own insurance arrangements are ultimately my responsibility and I will arrange any additional coverage at my expense after taking into account CAMS insurance arrangements, this document and my own circumstances.
